

AIMS Changing Payment Processor to PayPal

On January 19th, 2010 AIMS will migrate its existing payment processor to PayPal. When purchasing data, plats, or paying invoices online, AIMS customers will be presented with a PayPal screen to make a payment. Customers will still receive the same great service they've come to expect, but AIMS is retiring from the business of handling credit card information. AIMS will still accept credit cards as usual, but customers will now have the ability to pay with an existing PayPal account as well.
