### **Announcements**

### **Continuation of the February meeting**

#### **AIMS 2007 Accomplishments (Jay Heermann)**

- Jay reviewed some of the major accomplishments AIMS completed in 2007.

#### **2008 Plans (Steve Yoder and Dan Steen)**

- Steve discussed AIMS 2008 plan to organize markets around particular customer groups. These markets (utility, public safety, development, county services, and citizens) will then be the driving forces around our department initiatives.
- Some examples of new and existing products and services that AIMS plans to work on in 2008 were briefly mentioned (proposed zoning, benefit districts, deeds, address and property web service, etc.)
- Software that AIMS plans to upgrade this year was discussed (ArcGIS 9.3, SQL, Visual Studio 2008, FME, etc).
- Hardware upgrade plans were also discussed (ADMSAIMDSV01 server replacement, fiber lines from several cities to the county, etc)

### **Enhancements to myAIMS Applications**

#### **1. Changes to Johnson County Online Mapping (Dan Steen)**

- Demonstrated the use of the "Zoom Alternate" functionality in the IMS.
- Demonstrated the new oblique viewer
- Demonstrated the integration of the Lidar into the IMS when the mouse pauses.

- Street centerline and addresses have now been added into the IMS for the northern portions of Miami county.
2. RSS Feed (Brian Hiller)
    - Brian demonstrated how to subscribe to the new AIMS RSS feed.
    - RSS stands for Really Simple Syndication.
    - The feed provides news items and upcoming events.
  3. Proposed Zoning (Travis Wagner)
    - Travis described the project to capture proposed zoning.
    - As part of the project the IMS was altered to allow buffering of areas that are not parcels.
    - Gardner has been the pilot area and has adopted the application.
    - A website has been created to facilitate uploading of documents related to a rezoning.
    - Travis will be contacting cities about the possibility of adding their proposed zoning.

#### **ArcGIS Server (Keith Shaw)**

- Keith began his discussion by demonstrating the Human Services Application that AIMS has developed.
- Currently the data is only being updated weekly. We are not hitting the SDE data directly due to the locks that it creates. This will be resolved at 9.3.
- 15 scale levels were utilized.
- For the application, 4 geocoding services were also developed. These geocoding services can be utilized in Arcmap as well.
- An Address Search server task was also created. This cannot be used in Arcmap.
- Previous and Next zoom buttons were also created for the application. These are built in at 9.3.
