Olathe – Matt Steging

- Online mapping needs assessment
 - Survey sent out via newsletter
- AVL RFI
- Move from ArcGIS 10.1 to 10.2
 - Asset management (Cartegraph) needs to upgrade first
- Interested in Generic Asset Management Users Group
- Permitting Software – RFI was last year, RFP this year

EMC – Mark Whelan

- NG9-1-1 subcommittee
 - Meets weekly
 - Statewide mapping initiative to include address points, centerline and other ES layers
 - Countywide ES mapbook
 - Checking unbuilt streets
 - Multi-building guidebook
- Statewide imagery project
 - Surdex is vendor
 - 1 ft
 - ASPRS 1
 - No local QA/QC
 - Started late 2013, will finish flight early 2014
 - State leasing for \$600K annually
- Franklin County addressing

Westwood – Fred Sherman

- Operating with 1 license of ArcMAP
- Getting assistance from Mark on addressing
- Working with RTA to correct data inaccuracies in parcel fabric and annexation boundaries
- Instituted new Stormwater Utility Fee based on Sq. Ft. of impervious surface
 - Had to digitize decks, patios and driveways
- Westwood Hills is now a State Historic District
- Additional topics discussed:
 - Wal-Mart sales tax issues with Roeland Park
 - Talking to KU to understand logistics behind issuing 10,000 parking permits

- \$65 mixed-use development

- Discussed completing pipe condition assessment and how that has affected the process for issuing work orders
- Wants to move to Windows tablets from Dell
- Needs fiber to NE plant
- Enhancements to Lucity to web version to allow mobile access with fewer fields
 - Lucity does have android app and ipad app in dev.
- Permitting probably going with off shelf product

- Lots of projects using AGO
 - Sign and Stormwater guys are using IPADS in the field
 - Wants app for foreclosure inspections and rental inspection
 - Major 2014 focus is on mobile development
- Moving away from Lotus Notes to SQL - Intergov

- Made significant improvements to snow plow app
 - Was getting over 1,500 hits/hour
 - New legend, pop-ups and server
- Completed 5-year floodplain analysis
 - Hopes to save homeowners a few hundred bucks
- Tim revised neighborhood indicators
- Tree inventory moved to Lucity
 - Now maintained using mobile AGO app on Android tab
- Working on a few AGO pilot apps
- Goals:
 - Upgrade servers
 - SQL Spatial for AVL & snow plow app
 - Public Art and Arboretum apps using AGO
 - Get away from Flash to benefit IPAD users
 - Create mobile field apps using AGO
 - Organization moving to Gmail in April and Google Docs mid-2014
