

## AIMS Coordinators Meeting

### April 9, 2020 – approximately 31 participants

- Shannon talked about some of the various requests we have received and showed the JOCO Covid webpage (<https://maps.jocogov.org/covid19/>) and each of the dashboards within. Note: interactive dashboards are only accessible internally, otherwise, users should use the PDF links to view the same information.
- Several cities (OP, Olathe and Shawnee) said they really haven't had many requests, mainly the data are not granular enough for them.
- Olathe asked if they could get access to our data.
  - Dan said we really haven't received permission to share it externally due to PII. Hopefully we will have a new dashboard going externally this week with data aggregated up to zip codes.
- Jason suggested we show the DHE survey for JOCO residents, SP pulled up the county webpage (<https://www.jocogov.org/coronavirus-covid-19-update>) and showed how to access the survey. This survey is only open a short time but will be repeated to compare results over time.

- April said they have been inundated with requests from Health and Emergency folks. They have a self-reporting tool as well, using Survey123. Shannon pulled up the WYCO Covid website (<https://alpha.wycokck.org/Coronavirus-COVID-19-Information>).
  - One link we pulled up is their public dashboard, showing cases by zip code.
  - Much of the data they are receiving is coming in from excel documents. The dashboard is being feed by data pushed to AGO.
  - April also mentioned <http://status.arcgis.com/> is a good site to check if something is down.
- Andrea spoke a little about Douglas County and Shannon pulled up their hub (<https://coronavirus-response-dgco.hub.arcgis.com/>).
  - No symptom survey as of yet like JOCO and WYCO.
- Matt (Esri) said the JHU dashboard was getting 3 million hits an hour at one point.
- Steve said he'd still like to collaborate on long term effects such as business impacts and unemployment.
- Mike said May meeting will likely be different, may not still be interested in hosting.
