#### **1. Joplin Tornado - Mark Whelan**

Mark recently returned from tornado ravaged Joplin, MO, where he observed efforts at the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (USACE) Recovery Field Office. Among their many efforts are managing contracts for debris removal and rebuilding critical public facilities. Mark brought us specific information about the USACE's GIS capabilities.

#### **2. 2012 Orthophotography - Jerry Swingle**
