GIS Day 2004 – November – A quick show of hands revealed there are no plans by those in attendance to participate in GIS day this year.

GIS at the City of Shawnee

Doug Hemsath provided an overview of the GIS program at the City of Shawnee. The current GIS department at Shawnee consists of a single GIS staff member with some GIS work being done by non-GIS staff in other departments. The City is currently in the process of consolidating spatial data into a centralized data location and promoting enterprise access through current ESRI technologies. The objective is to make better use of the existing data.

City maintained data includes address points, zoning, stormwater utility, street lights, controllers, lines, signs, and auto accidents.

The city demoed some of the application development they are doing using ArcPublisher, Model Builder, and ArcScene. The goal is to use ArcPublisher as a lightweight GIS data viewer on the City's intranet. Some disappointment was expressed in the performance and limitations of some of these technologies.

Ongoing Johnson County Planimetric Updates

Shannon Porter with Johnson County, AIMS gave an overview of the current status and results of updating planimetric building features in those areas not updated by the consultant. The update project was successful and there will likely be similar update projects in the future for additional planimetric features.
